We see de Kalb's gallant death under a cavalry charge at Camden. We penetrate Marion's swamp-encircled stronghold on the Pee Dee. We watch the cat-and-mouse game between Cornwallis

and Lafayette. Dawn's Early Light is the human story behind our first war for liberty, and of the men and women loving and laughing through it to the dawn of a better world. This volume presents the most recent research on American illustrator Howard Pyle, with thematic essays by leading scholars. Contributors offer fresh perspectives on Pyle's familiar images by exploring his interaction with the art and culture of his time, effectively repositioning him within the broader spectrum of nineteenth-century art.
